ORDINANCE NO. **11994**

AN ORDINANCE relating to vehicle parking adjacent to the Kingdome; setting the parking rate and hours of availability in the Kingdome parking lots; amending Ordinance No. 7017 Section 4, as amended, and K.C.C. 22.12.030 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 7017, Section 4, as amended, and K.C.C. 22.12.030 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Daily Parking Fees

Any person parking a vehicle in the Kingdome parking lot on a daily basis will pay according to the following schedule:

1. Non-Event Day Parking (includes sales tax):

North Parking Lot A

Days, <u>(6:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.)</u> 0 to 3 hours	\$3.00 per parking <u>((stall)) space</u>
Days, <u>(6:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.)</u> over 3 hours until 2:00 a.m.	\$5.00 per parking <u>((stall)) space</u>
Evenings, from 5:00 p.m. until 2:00 a.m.	\$ 3.00 per parking <u>((stall)) space</u>
<u>Overnight</u>	<u>\$ 8.00 per parking space</u>

South Parking Lot B and Lot C

Evenings (5:00 p.m. until ((12:00-midnight)) <u>2:00 a.m.</u>)	\$ 2.00 per parking <u>((stall)) space</u>
Days (6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.)	\$ 2.00 per parking <u>((stall)) space</u>

Daily parking is subject to availability, as determined by the director of the department of stadium administration.

2. Event Day Parking in North Parking Lot A, South Parking Lot B, and Lot C

~~((all))~~ Kingdome lots (includes sales tax):

~~((Vehicles under 23 feet in length))~~

For Seattle professional football games, thrill shows, ~~((concerts, and all playoff or championship college and professional sport events))~~ and professional basketball exhibition

1 playoff games. The director's authority to establish separate parking rates shall expire on
2 December 31, 1995.

3 ~~C. Effective date. The effective date of this section is ((January 1, 1994))~~ September
4 30, 1995.

5 NEW SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provisions of the King County code
6 related to advertising requirements, this ordinance shall become effective immediately.
7 The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this
8 ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or
9 for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
