Ordinance 11068 authorized the 26.1 acre City of Bothell Sammamish River Greenway 1993 Regional Conservation Futures Acquisition Bond project, which included in the project description the following: "The Project will purchase development rights on a portion of the "front nine" of the Wayne Golf Course, and will require continued public availability to the golf course at prices equivalent to publicly-owned golf courses in King County."

2. The City has requested a change in the project scope description to allow for purchase of a 45.61 acre conservation easement and allowing for public availability to the course at prices equivalent to privately-owned golf courses open to the public in King County.

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an enlargement of the scope of the City of Bothell Sammamish River Greenway 1993 Regional Conservation Futures Acquisition Bond project to 45.61 acres in size and changing project

1 scope description to reflect a requirement that the golf
 2 course should be available to the public at prices equivalent
 3 to other privately-owned golf courses available for public
 4 use, provided however, that the King County Surface Water
 5 Management Division and the City of Bothell shall work
 6 cooperatively with the property owner to develop a stream
 7 restoration plan for the portions of the property located
 8 along the Sammamish River. The plan should include, but not
 9 be limited to, volunteer stream restoration projects and
 10 property owner incentive programs, and provided further that
 11 the property owner will not be responsible for any costs
 12 associated with the stream restoration work.
