ORDINANCE NO. **12136**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Board of Appeals and Equalization and amending policy regarding compensation for board members and hearing examiners; amending Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended and K.C.C. 2.34.050.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended and K.C.C. 2.34.050 are hereby amended as follows:

Compensation. A. Effective ((January)) June 1, 19((89))95, for each six-hour day devoted to official work of the board, each member and each hearing examiner employed by the board thereof shall receive a per diem allowance of one hundred and ((twenty-five)) fifty dollars except that a per diem allowance of ((seventy)) eighty-five dollars shall be paid for official board work of more than four hours but less than six hours.

B. ((Effective January 1, 1989 for each six hour day devoted to the official work of the board, each hearing examiner employed by the board shall receive a per diem allowance of one hundred and ten dollars; provided, that a per diem allowance of sixty five dollars shall be paid for official examiner work of more than four hours but less than six hours.

C. ~~For time devoted to the official work of the board in cases where due to a change of venue, the appeal is heard~~
