ORDINANCE NO. **12193**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$42,000 to the Technology Systems Fund from Special Programs-Executive Contingency for the development of an integrated superior court-judicial administration business plan for automation and information technology, and amending Ordinance 12029, sections 37, 40, 110, and Attachment 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$42,000 to the superior court from Special Programs - Executive Contingency to support the development of an integrated business plan to utilize technology for the joint automation of superior court and department of judicial administration operations.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 37, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby disappropriated from:

Special Programs - Executive Contingency (\$42,000)

SECTION 3. Ordinance 12029, Section 40, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SECTION 5. Ordinance 12029, Section 110, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance.




