ORDINANCE NO. **12376**

AN ORDINANCE making supplemental appropriations of \$494,120 to Alcoholism & Substance Abuse; \$2,222,153 to Public Health Pooling; and a transfer of \$383,821 from the Health Centers Construction Fund 333 to the Building Repair and Replacement Fund 395, and amending Ordinance 12029, Sections 79, 85, 110 and Attachment 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. is hereby approved and adopted, supplemental appropriations of \$494,120 to Alcoholism & Substance Abuse; \$2,222,153 to Public Health Pooling, as a result of an amendment the State Department of Health Consolidated Contracts and other grants and contracts; and authorizing a transfer of \$383,821 from the Health Centers Construction Fund 333 to the Building Repair and Replacement Fund 331 for the Medical Examiner Project.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 79, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PROVIDED THAT: In accordance with its terms as amended, no funds provided by the U.S. Conference of Mayor's "Preventing the Spread of HIV via Prostitution" grant shall be used to purchase condoms, nor be used by any County employee for the purchase and/or distribution of condoms to prostitutes. In addition to preventing the spread of HIV via prostitution. the grant money shall only be used to encourage prostitutes to leave prostitution. The Health Department will report to Budget and Fiscal Management Committee in six months regarding its progress on pursuing funding for programs helping women to leave the sex industry.
