

6 ORDINANCE NO. **12388**

8 AN ORDINANCE extending electrical franchise numbers 595 and  
9 7225 for Seattle City Light through October 31, 1996, authorizing  
10 the issuance of right of way construction permits in Council  
11 Districts 1, 5 and 8.

13 STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 15 1. Seattle City Light's electrical franchise numbers 595 and 7225 to operate and  
16 maintain an electrical system on county roads in council districts 1, 5 and 8 will expire  
17 on February 29, 1996.
- 19 2. The City of Seattle has requested renewal of said franchises.
- 21 3. King County Ordinance 11936 extended franchise numbers 595 and 7225 through  
22 February 29, 1996 so that the City of Seattle would have additional time to review the  
23 terms and conditions of the new franchise.
- 25 4. The Seattle Office of Management and Planning has conducted an interdepartmental  
26 review of the county's proposed franchise terms and conditions and has raised several  
27 issues which will not be resolved before the franchise extensions lapse.
- 29 5. The extension of the franchises through October 31, 1996 will allow sufficient time  
30 to conclude negotiations and obtain both city council and county council approval of the  
31 new franchise.
- 33 6. The extensions of electrical franchise numbers 595 and 7225 have been referred to  
34 relevant county departments for review.
- 36 7. No objections have been raised to the granting of these extensions.

38 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

40 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 6.27 to the contrary,  
41 the King County executive is hereby authorized to grant an extension of electrical franchise  
42 numbers 595 and 7225 for Seattle City Light through October 31, 1996, in substantially the  
43 same form as Attachment "A". Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 14.44 to  
44 the contrary, the executive is also authorized to issue right of way construction permits  
45 consistent with terms of the extended franchise. Right of way construction permits issued by  
46 the property services division and the roads services division between February 29, 1996 and  
47 the date of execution of the franchise extension agreements by King County and the City of

1 Seattle shall be considered issued under the terms of the original franchises and the franchise  
2 extension agreements.


3 SECTION 2. If within sixty days after the granting of these extensions, the grantee  
4 shall have failed to sign the franchise extension agreements incorporated herein, then the  
5 rights and privileges granted herein shall be forfeited and said franchises shall be null and  
6 void.

7 SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists  
8 and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or  
9 safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.




