2 AN ORDINANCE extending water system franchise 820
3 for the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club
4 until November 10, 1997, and authorizing the
5 issuance of right-of-way construction permits in
6 Council District 3.

7 STATEMENT OF FACTS

8 1. The Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club Franchise
9 820, to operate and maintain a water system on County road
10 rights-of-way, will expire on May 10, 1996.

11 2. The Club filed an application for a water franchise
12 extension in Council District 3 on April 22, 1996 to construct,
13 operate, and maintain their existing water system to serve a
14 single family residential area.

15 3. King County Code Chapter 6.27 requires that the utility
16 franchise application be approved by the Utilities Technical
17 Review Committee (UTRC) and be consistent with the County's
18 comprehensive plan, Seattle-King County health department and
19 the State department of health regulations.

20 4. The Club is in the process of preparing and obtaining
21 approval of its water comprehensive plan to bring it in
22 compliance with the state and county regulations. The Club
23 anticipates that this process will take a year and a half to
24 complete.

25 5. In order to provide the Club with the time needed to
26 complete its water plan and to allow the Club to continue to
27 operate and maintain the existing water system on county road
28 rights-of-way, the Club has requested that Franchise 820 be
29 extended.

30 6. The extension for Water Franchise 820 has been referred
31 to the relevant County departments for review.

32 7. The County executive has recommended approval of the
33 water franchise extension.

1 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

2 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter
3 13.24 to the contrary, the King County executive is hereby
4 authorized to grant an extension of Water Franchise 820 for the
5 Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club until November 10, 1997,
6 in substantially the same form as Attachment "A".
7 Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 14.44 to the
8 contrary, the executive is also authorized to issue right-of-
9 way construction permits consistent with the terms of the
10 extended franchise.

FRANCHISE EXTENSION AGREEMENT

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club currently holds water franchise 820 granted by King County, Washington for the operation of its water system in unincorporated King County; and

WHEREAS, the referenced Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club franchise will expire on May 10, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club has requested an extension of said franchise; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club, King County and the Utilities Technical Review Committee recommend that said franchise be extended until November 10, 1997 to give the Club the opportunity to complete and obtain approval of its water comprehensive plan and franchise; and

WHEREAS, no objections have been raised to the granting of the request; and

WHEREAS, King County has approved the extension of this franchise until November 10, 1997 through the passage of Ordinance No. 12396 subject to the conditions contained in the ordinance and agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, King County, Washington and the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club, agree as follows:

1. The terms of King County Water Franchise 820 is hereby approved and extended so that it will now expire on November 10, 1997.
2. All other conditions of King County Water Franchise 820 shall remain in full force and effect and are not modified or amended by this agreement or Ordinance No. 12396.
