ORDINANCE NO. **12491**

AN ORDINANCE approving a franchise for Mirrormont Services, Inc. to construct, operate and maintain a water system in Council District 12, and authorizing the Executive to execute the franchise agreement.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. Mirrormont Services, Inc. has filed an application for a franchise in council district 12 to construct, operate and maintain a water system to serve residential areas in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010 and K.C.C. 6.27.
2. The district's comprehensive plan was approved on March 18, 1996, by King County council Ordinance 12173.
3. The application has been referred to the relevant county departments for review; no objections have been raised to granting the franchise.
4. The King County executive has recommended approval of the franchise.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The granting of a franchise to Mirrormont Services, Inc. to construct, operate and maintain a water system within King County is hereby approved. The King County executive is authorized to enter into and execute the water system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.
