ORDINANCE NO. 12530

A ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$300,000 to the Cultural Development Fund from an award from the Puget Sound Regional Council's Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act, and amending Ordinance 12029, Section 75, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$300,000 to cultural resources from an award from the Puget Sound Regional Council's Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) for restoration of the midship hull of the historic Steamer Virginia V.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 75, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
