2 AN ORDINANCE relating to elections,
3 calling for special elections to be held
4 to nominate and to elect persons to fill
5 the prescribed elective offices for the
6 newly incorporated city of Covington and
7 declaring an emergency.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. Pursuant to RCW 35.02.078 and RCW 29.13.010,
10 the county council hereby calls for the records and elections
11 division manager, as supervisor of elections, to hold special
12 elections for the purpose of nominating and electing persons
13 to the elective offices prescribed by law for the city of
14 Covington based on its population and its classification as a
15 non-charter code city with a council-manager form of
16 government

17 SECTION 2. The primary to nominate candidates for the

the council deems an emergency to exist for the purposes of
calling these special elections.

SECTION 5. The county council finds as a fact and
declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is
necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,
health or safety or for the support of county government and
its existing public institutions.
