ORDINANCE NO. **12710**

AN ORDINANCE relating to no shooting areas, establishing a no shooting area near Palmer, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.68.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The shooting of firearms is prohibited and a no-shooting area is established near Palmer within the Green River voting precinct and described as follows:

A. Beginning at the intersection of South 307<sup>th</sup> Street and Burlington Northern Railroad, then Northerly and following the Burlington Northern Railroad to Cumberland Kanaskat Road, then south along Cumberland Kanaskat Road to where it intersects with South 307<sup>th</sup> Street, then west and Northwesterly along South 307<sup>th</sup> Street to the point of the beginning.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1997.

PASSED by a vote of 11 to 0 this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1997.
