ORDINANCE NO. **12713**

AN ORDINANCE pertaining to election officers and polling places, adjusting the rates of compensation for precinct election officials, cancelling the compensation for deputy registrars; amending Ordinance 9391, and K.C.C. 1.08.020; repealing Ordinance 918, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 1.08.020; and Ordinance 917, Section 1 and K.C.C. 1.08.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 918, Section 1 as amended, and K.C.C.

1.08.010 is repealed.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 9391, and K.C.C. 1.08.020 are hereby amended as follows:

Inspectors and judges - compensation. The manager, records and elections division, is authorized and directed to compensate election inspectors and judges at the following rates.
