- 1. A petition has been filed requesting the vacation of that portion of South 284th Street hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of transportation has notified various utility companies serving the area and have been advised that Highline Water District and Lakehaven Water and Sewer District will be securing easements through the developer extension agreement. No other easements are required.
- 3. The department of development and environmental services, land use services division has reviewed the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of transportation found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A review of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement, or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way unnecessary as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified "C-Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the assessed value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$6,228.99 from the petitioner.
