ORDINANCE NO.

**12880**

AN ORDINANCE relating to no shooting areas, establishing a no shooting area near Carnation, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.68.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The shooting of firearms is prohibited and a no-shooting area is established near Carnation within the Vincent voting precinct and described as follows:

A. Bounded on the north by the north line of Section 20-25-7 (extension of N.E. 40 Street). On the east by the Snoqualmie River. On the south by Tolt Hill Road. On the west by the east boundary line for the Ames Lake No Shooting Area per K.C.C. 12.68.440.







In response to your memo dated July 25, 1996, the Division of Records and Elections has examined the signatures contained on the petition filed in support of the proposed no shooting area located in the Carnation area, pursuant to reference (a).

Of the signatures that were compared against those on file with this Division, 14 were determined to be registered voters of VINCENT Precinct, the only precinct included in the proposed no shooting area. Since that number exceeds the ten signatures per precinct required to certify, it is determined that the petition is sufficient.


