ORDINANCE NO. **12910**

AN ORDINANCE relating to elections, calling for special elections to be held to nominate and to elect persons to fill the prescribed elective offices for the newly incorporated city of Kenmore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to RCW 35.02.078 and RCW 29.13.010, the county council hereby calls for the records and elections division manager, as supervisor of elections, to hold special elections for the purpose of nominating and electing persons to the elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Kenmore based on its population and its classification as a non-charter code city with a council-manager form of government.

SECTION 2. The primary to nominate candidates for the prescribed elective positions shall be held at a special election occurring on Tuesday, February 3, 1998; and the special election to fill the prescribed elective positions shall be held on Tuesday, April 28, 1998.

SECTION 3. Both special elections shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable laws and ordinances, including those related to the filing and withdrawal of candidacy declarations contained in Chapter 29.15 and 35.02 RCW.

SECTION 5. Pursuant to Chapters 29.13 and 35.02 RCW, the council deems an emergency to exist for the purposes of calling these special elections.




