ORDINANCE NO.

12919

AN ORDINANCE relating to marriage license fees; amending Ordinance 5220, Sections 1 and 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 6.80.010, and K.C.C. 6.80.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5220, Section 1, and K.C.C. 6.80.010; is amended to read as follows:

Fees. The fee for a marriage license((s)), as authorized by RCW 26.04.160, 26.12.220, 36.18.010, 36.22.170 and 36.22.175, shall be ~~((increased by eight dollars for a total fee of sixteen (\$16.00) as authorized by HB 829, Section 1, paragraph 1 (Chapter 124, Regular Session, 46th Legislature, 1980))~~ \$52.00.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 5220, Section 2, and K.C.C. 6.80.020 is amended to read as follows:

Disposition of funds. The county shall ~~((use the proceeds from the fee increase to pay the expenses of family court under RCW Chapter 26.12 in addition to any other funds used therefore.))~~ distribute the marriage license fees as follows. For each license sold:

A. King County Fees

1. \$ 8.00 - King County General Fund (RCW 36.18.010).

2. \$ 8.00 - King County Family Court Fund (RCW 26.12.220), to

be used to pay for expenses of family court under Chapter 26.12 RCW.

1 3. \$ 2.00 - King County Records Preservation Fund (RCW
2 36.22.170), to be deposited in the Records and Elections Operational
3 and Maintenance fund for ongoing preservation of historical documents.

4 4. \$15.00 - King County Family Services Fund (RCW 26.04.160),
5 to be used to fund family services.

6 Fees collected in Section 2.A1. through A4. above shall be deposited
7 in the same manner as other county funds and shall be maintained in a
8 separate account.

9 B. State of Washington Fees

10 1. \$10.00 - State of Washington Displaced Homemaker program
11 (RCW 36.18.010), to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer and
12 deposited in the state general fund for the purposes of the displaced
13 homemaker act, chapter 28B.04 RCW.

14 2. \$ 5.00 - State of Washington Child Abuse program (RCW
15 36.18.010), to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer for use
16 and support of the prevention of child abuse and neglect activities.

17 3. \$ 2.00 - State of Washington Records Preservation program
18 (RCW 36.22.170), to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer who
19 shall distribute such funds to each county treasurer within the state
20 in July of each year in accordance with the formula described in RCW
21 36.22.190 for ongoing preservation of historical documents of all
22 county offices and departments.

23 4. \$2.00 - Surcharge for Archives and Records Management
24 (RCW 36.22.175), to be transmitted monthly to the state treasurer for
25 deposit in the archives and records management account.

2 Fees collected shall be deposited in the same manner as other
3 county funds and shall be maintained in a separate account.
