ORDINANCE NO. **12993**

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying of property taxes of King County for the year 1998 and amending the legislation establishing the property tax levy for taxes to be collected in 1998, Ordinance 12958, Sections 2 and 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 12958, Section 2, is amended to read as follows: The metropolitan King County council finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for the year 1998, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues, be and the same are fixed as follows:




