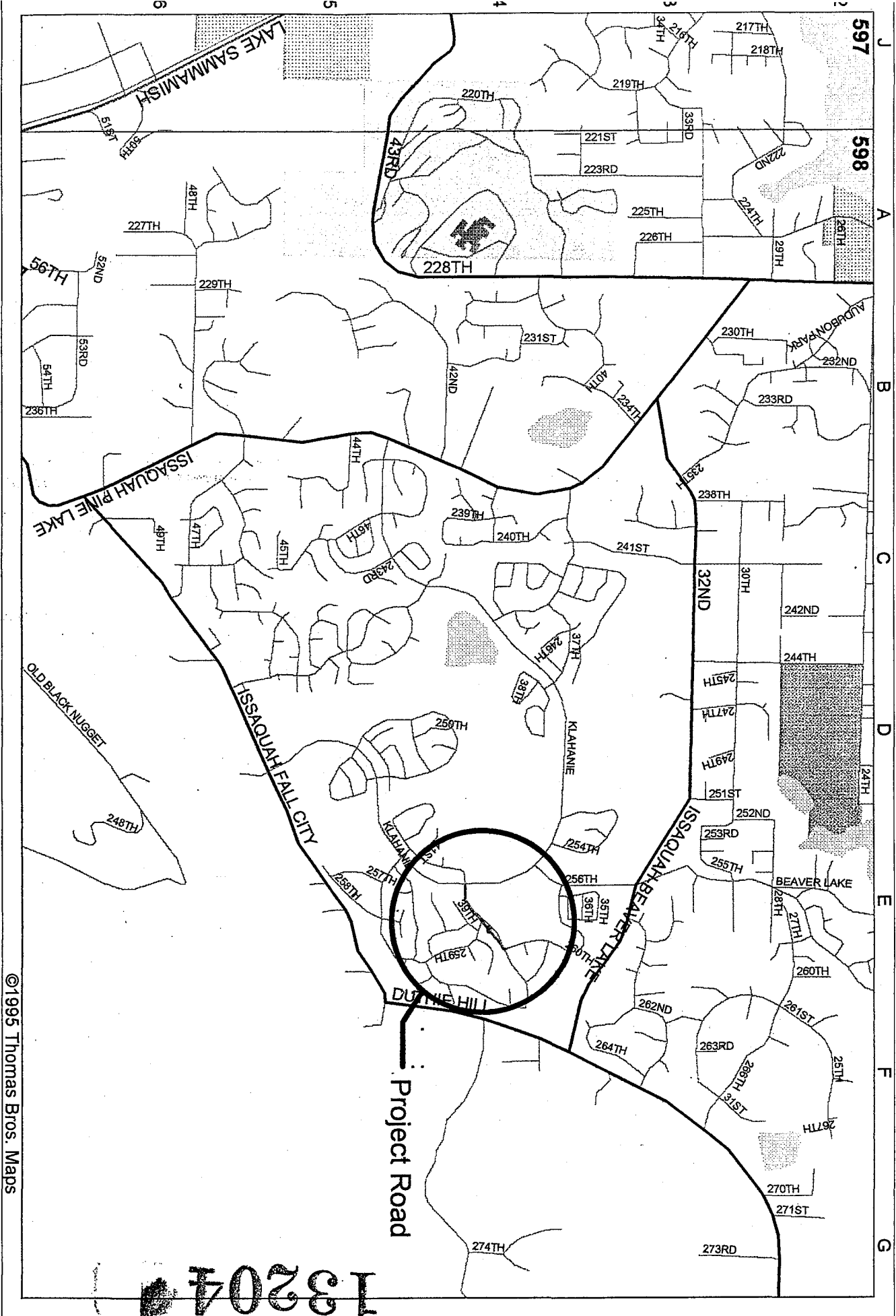

PETITION TO RESTRICT PARKING ON SE 39th WAY

This petition is to document homeowner support for further restriction to parking on SE 39th Way directly adjacent to the Summerwalk Apartments in the Klahanie development. The current situation allows parking on both sides of SE 39th Way in the area of the Summerwalk Apartments. This current parking situation, together with the natural curvature of the road, produces an unsafe situation, both for traffic and for pedestrians. The undersigned propose that parking be allowed only on the North side of SE 39th Way (side directly adjacent to the Summerwalk Apartments) between Klahanie Boulevard and 260th Ave SE. No parking should be allowed on the South side of SE 39th Way between Klahanie Boulevard and 260th Ave SE. This arrangement will rectify the current safety problem and still allow for reasonable on-road parking adjacent to the Summerwalk Apartments even though adequate parking is also provided within the apartment development itself.

Through this petition, the undersigned parties, who are single family home owners directly affected by the problem parking situation described above, request that King County take appropriate action to restrict parking along SE 39th Way, as requested.

Dear Mr. McMillen:

This letter is intended to resubmit a request for action by King County that was originally submitted to your attention by means of my letter dated April 23, 1996. This earlier letter included a petition signed by an overwhelming number of my neighbors, who, like me, are homeowners, and taxpayers. I have actively followed this request, offering any further assistance or documentation that would support action by King County. This included at least monthly phone calls to your office. Most recently, I requested a personal meeting with you to review the status of this request and to ascertain what additional information, if any, was required to allow this request to be recommended for action and processed through the system. Based on this personal meeting with you during the month of June, I understand that this request has substantial merit and now also has the proper level of attention, including that of Lloyd Neal and Harold Taniguchi of King County. Based on your recommendation and to further strengthen this request, I have obtained additional petition signatures to complement those which were obtained earlier. These additional petition signatures and the original letter and petition which you had returned to me in June are attached to this letter. Regarding my petition efforts, you should be aware that every neighbor, who was at home when I collected signatures, enthusiastically signed this petition. It is my understanding, from discussions with you, that the combination of these new signatures, together with those originally obtained, will provide a sufficient and substantial basis for you to recommend that King County take the actions requested.


Dear Bruce Barrett:
