ORDINANCE NO. **13370**

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Personnel Board,
3 providing for administrative support to the board, and authorizing
4 per diem to board members for official board business; amending
5 K.C.C. 3.08.110 and Ordinance 174 (part), as amended; and
6 adding a new section to K.C.C. 3.08.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. Ordinance 174 (part), as amended, and K.C.C. 3.08.110, are hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 **Compensation.** For time devoted to the official work of the personnel board, each
11 member thereof shall receive a per diem of ~~((fifty))~~ one hundred dollars to be paid out of the
12 current expense fund; provided that a per diem of ~~((twenty-five))~~ seventy five dollars shall be paid
13 for official board work of three hours or less; provided further that an additional twenty-five
14 dollars per day will be paid to the chair of the board during any full day (six hours or more) or
15 thirteen dollars for work of three hours or less in which board business is conducted. The County
16 is further authorized to pay for reasonable parking expenses of personnel board members while
17 board business is conducted.

18 Further, the executive shall report back to the council no later than December 31, 1999 on
19 the expenses incurred during the calendar year of 1999 at the new per diem rate and shall make
20 recommendations to the council on any further adjustments to the per diem rate as may be needed
21 at that time.

22 SECTION 2. NEW SECTION. There is hereby added to K.C.C. 3.08 a new section to
23 read as follows:

December 8, 1998

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Administrative support. Beginning January 1, 1999, administrative support to the personnel board will be provided by the clerk of the board of appeals and equalization authorized by K.C.C. 2.34.040. Authority for appointment of the clerk and staff will remain with the board of appeals and equalization; however, the chair of the personnel board may bring concerns about performance and related issues to the attention of the chair of the board of appeals and equalization for resolution

The board of appeals and equalization will be reimbursed by the office of human resources management for costs related to personnel board activities such as board per diem, supplies, and services other than staffing, employee benefits, and office equipment.
