On April 6, 1998, the council passed Ordinance 13072, requiring a vote of the citizens of King County on whether or not county facilities, services or funds should be used to help host the 2012 Summer Olympics. At the time of its passage, it was anticipated that the Seattle Bid Committee would make a formal bid to the United States Olympic Committee to host the Olympics. A formal bid to host the Olympics was not submitted, making a public vote unnecessary.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:




