

1 A one-time exception to K.C.C. 7.12.640 is necessary to authorize the park system
2 to issue a limited and restricted special use permit allowing sale and consumption
3 of alcoholic beverages at a designated site within Fort Dent Park ballfield complex
4 during the Men's Masters 45 & Over Slow Pitch Softball National Championship
5 Tournament.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. An exception to K.C.C. 7.12.640 is hereby granted, authorizing the
8 executive through the director of parks and recreation to issue a special use permit to Team
9 Seattle National Events Committee, thereby allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic
10 beverages at a designated hospitality site at Fort Dent Park, on September 10 through 12,
11 1999.

12 SECTION 2. The serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages must be
13 confined to the designated location, and must conform to the requirements of the
14 Washington State Liquor Control Board under Title 66 RCW.

15 SECTION 3. The executive and director of parks and recreation shall assure that
16 the Team Seattle National Events Committee has adequate insurance coverage and that the
17 county is named as an additional insured by the Team Seattle National Events Committee
18 before a permit is issued.

19 SECTION 4. Ordinance 6798, Section 64, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.12.640 are each
20 hereby amended to read as follows:

21 **Alcoholic beverages.** Selling, opening((;)) or possessing alcoholic beverages in an
22 open container, or consuming any alcoholic beverage in a King County park, recreation
23 area((;)) or associated marine area is prohibited except in the following designated areas
24 subject to approval by the manager and under the following conditions:

25 A. The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is permissible in the club
26 house at the Enumclaw golf course.

1 B. The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is permissible for special use
2 permit groups at the King County fairgrounds, ~~((provided that))~~ if the activities conform to
3 the requirements of the Washington State Liquor Control Board ~~((pursuant to))~~ under Title
4 66~~((7))~~ RCW


5 C. The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is permissible at designated
6 indoor and outdoor locations within Marymoor Park, King County Aquatic Center and
7 indoors at the Lake Wilderness Center, Gold Creek Lodge in Woodinville and Issaquah
8 Lodge at Beaver Lake by special use permit groups, ~~((provided that))~~ if the activities
9 conform to the requirements of the Washington State Liquor Control Board ~~((pursuant to))~~
10 under Title 66~~((7))~~ RCW, and that ~~((such))~~ the serving and consumption is confined to the
11 designated location. The director shall designate the locations within the park ~~((and~~
12 ~~recreational facility}))~~ and recreational facility where ~~((such))~~ the activity is permissible.
13 The director of parks and recreation may issue a special use permit to the Team Seattle
14 National Events Committee, allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages by

1 the special use permit group at Fort Dent Park, during the Men's Masters 45 & Over Slow
2 Pitch Softball National Championship Tournament for the inclusive dates of September 10
3 through 12, 1999.
