

1 3. Review and comment on proposed emergency management rules, policies or
2 ordinances before the adoption of the rules, policies or ordinances.

3 D. 1. The county executive shall appoint regular members of the committee,
4 subject to confirmation by county council motion.

5 2. Individuals serving as members of the committee shall be the chair of the
6 association or designee if an association or agency is named as a member. This includes
7 the Suburban Cities Association, which shall designate the individuals to serve as its
8 representative members.

9 3. Individuals serving the committee from industry groups shall be recruited
10 with the assistance of the industry.

11 4. A member of the committee shall serve a term of three years or until the
12 member's successor is appointed and confirmed as provided in this section. The terms of
13 office shall be staggered consistent with K.C.C. chapter 2.28.

14 5. Memberships are not limited as to numbers of terms, but members shall
15 participate in a reappointment process every three years. Reappointment is subject to
16 confirmation by county council.

17 6. A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term of the vacant position
18 in the manner described in the initial appointment.

19 E. 1. The committee shall elect a committee member as chair by a majority vote of
20 committee members. The term of the chair is one year.

21 2. The committee shall adopt appropriate bylaws, including quorum
22 requirements.

1 F. The emergency management division shall provide ongoing administrative
2 support to the committee.

3 G. Members of the committee shall serve without compensation.




