7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of
9 \$845,000 to safety and claims management from the unexpended safety and workers
10 compensation fund balance. This supplemental appropriation will fund higher than budgeted
11 medical and time loss costs associated with workers compensation claims.

12 SECTION 2. Ordinance 13340, Section 106, as amended, is hereby amended by
13 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

14 SAFETY AND CLAIMS MANAGEMENT – From the safety and workers
15 compensation fund there is hereby appropriated to:




