1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of  
2 \$192,275 to adult and juvenile detention from executive  
3 contingency; and amending the 2000 Budget Ordinance,  
4 Ordinance 13678, Sections 44 and 40, as amended.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted supplemental appropriation  
9 of \$192,275 to department of adult and juvenile detention for the juvenile division and a  
10 disappropriation of \$192,275 from executive contingency.

11 SECTION 2. Ordinance 13678, Section 44, as amended, is hereby amended by  
12 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

13 ADULT AND JUVENILE DETENTION – From the current expense fund there  
14 is hereby appropriated to:

15 Adult and juvenile detention \$192,275

16 The additional FTEs for adult and juvenile detention shall be: 2.10

17 PROVIDED THAT: It is intent of the council that the opening of a new living

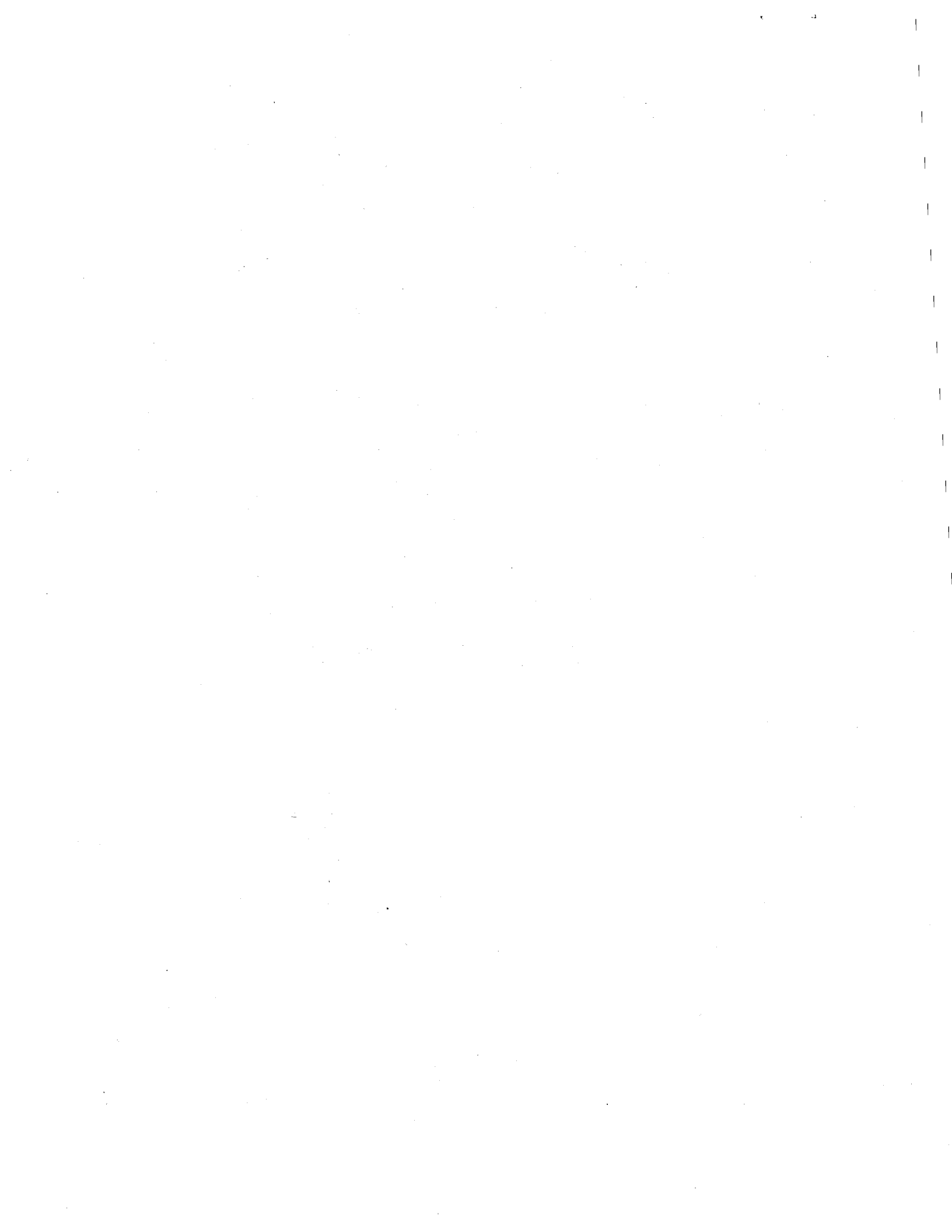


## Ordinance 13902

18 unit for non-offender youth at the county's juvenile detention facility is an interim  
19 measure to avoid potential litigation and is not the ultimate solution for housing non-  
20 offender youth. Further, it is the intent of the council that the executive convene a work  
21 group to develop, in collaboration with the superior court, office of the prosecuting  
22 attorney, sheriff, budget office, public defenders and Columbia Legal Services, possible  
23 options for addressing the need for secure or supervised placements for non-offender  
24 youth. The executive shall report the findings and recommendations of the work group to  
25 the council by October 1, 2000. The report should also identify whether other  
26 governmental agencies are meeting their responsibilities for King County youth subject  
27 to civil petitions under the state's "Becca" laws.

28 SECTION 3. Ordinance 13678, Section 40, as amended is hereby amended by  
29 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

30 EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY – From the current expense fund there is hereby






