1 AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, prohibiting
2 stopping, standing, or parking during certain hours on
3 certain streets as authorized under K.C.C. 46.04.060A.3;
4 and amending Ordinance 5292, schedule 16.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Based on traffic engineering studies carried out by the department
8 of transportation, road services division and as authorized under K.C.C. 46.04.060A.3,
9 Schedule 16 of Ordinance 5292, which prohibits stopping, standing, or parking during
10 certain hours on certain streets, is amended to add the following roadways:

11 41st Avenue South, on the east and west sides, between South 288th Place and
12 South 291st Street, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days only.

13 42nd Avenue South, on the east and west sides, between South 288th Street and a
14 point 60 feet south of South 291st Street, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days
15 only.

16 South 288th Place, on the north and south sides, between 41st Avenue South and
17 east to the cul-de-sac, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days only.

18 South 289th Place, on the north and south sides, between 42nd Avenue South and
19 east to the cul-de-sac, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days only.

20 South 290th Street, on the north and south sides, between 42nd Avenue South to a
21 point 200 feet east of 42nd Avenue South, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days
22 only.

23 South 291st Street, on the north and south sides between 42nd Avenue South to a
24 point 50 feet west of 41st Avenue South, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days
25 only.

26 SECTION 2. Signs posted to evidence the above-described restriction shall be
27 installed by the proper authority.


