1 AN ORDINANCE making corrections to capital
2 improvements sections of the 2000 Adopted Budget; and
3 amending the 2000 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 13678,
4 Sections 121 and 123 and Attachments 3 and 5, as amended.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation
7 of \$4,196,500 to the SWM CIP non-bond sub-fund 3292 to fund projects to address
8 flooding, drainage and degraded habitat, authorization to disappropriate \$3,356,000 from
9 SWM CIP contingency project, and authorization to disappropriate \$150,000 from ESA
10 Contingency project. From the surface and storm water management construction fund
11 3180 there is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$1,453,000 to
12 fund projects including King County's share in reducing flood hazards on the Snoqualmie
13 river, purchasing flood prone homes, and elevating flood prone homes. To the open
14 space non-bond county projects fund 3522 there is hereby appropriated \$320,000 to
15 purchase property on the Cedar River and Bear Creek.

16 SECTION 2. An appropriation of \$4,196,500 to the SWM CIP non-bond sub-
17 fund 3292 will provide funding for projects as detailed in Attachment 1 to this ordinance.

18 An appropriation of \$1,453,000 from the Surface and Storm Water Management
19 Construction Fund 3180 will provide funding for projects as detailed in Attachment 1 to
20 this ordinance. An appropriation of \$320,000 to open space non-bond county projects
21 fund 3522 will provide funding for projects as detailed in Attachment 1 to this ordinance.
22 A disappropriation of (\$3,506,000) in SWM CIP non-bond fund 3292 will disappropriate
23 (\$3,356,000) from the SWM CIP contingency project and (\$150,000) from the ESA
24 contingency project.

25 SECTION 3. Ordinance 13678, Section 121, as amended, is hereby amended by
26 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

31 From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated
32 and authorized to be disbursed the amounts for the specific projects identified in
33 Attachment 1 to this ordinance.

34 SECTION 4. Ordinance 13678, Attachment 3, as amended, is hereby amended by
35 adding thereto and inserting therein the projects listed in Attachment 1 of this ordinance.

36 **PROVIDED THAT:**

37 \$200,000 from Fund 3292, project 0C1395 Coal Creek Upstream Improvements,
38 shall be expended solely on a joint study or studies of erosion and sediment deposition in
39 Coal Creek ravine pursuant to an interlocal agreement with the City of Bellevue. The
40 county shall not expend or encumber more than one-half (1/2) of the cost of each study.

41 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:

42 No funds from Fund 3292, project XXXX ESA Related Feasibility Studies, shall
43 be expended or encumbered on biological assessments.

44 SECTION 5. Ordinance 13678, Section 123, as amended, is hereby amended by
45 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:






