1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$500,000 to SWM CIP
2 non-bond fund 3292 to implement the early action rural
3 drainage CIP program and authorizing expenditures from
4 fund 3292; and amending the 2000 Budget Ordinance,
5 Ordinance 13678, Section 121 and Attachments 2 and 3, as
6 amended.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation
9 of \$500,000 to SWM CIP fund 3292 to be funded from fees collected in the rural portion
10 of the SWM service area, also known as rural drainage program fees. This appropriation
11 increases the transfer of \$1,127,900 authorized by the council on January 10,2000; in
12 Ordinance 13705, Section 1, by an additional \$500,000, making the transfer a total of
13 \$1,627,900 from SWM fund 121 to SWM CIP non-bond fund 3292. This appropriation
14 shall be expended as follows: \$75,000 to Shamrock Park; \$100,000 to Tuck Creek Phase
15 II; \$100,000 to Shinglemill/Judkins Creek on Vashon/Maury Island; \$100,000 to LMO
16 Cost Share Program; \$75,000 to Rural Community Partnership Grants Project; \$50,000 to
17 Rural DHI project.

18 SECTION 2. Ordinance 13678, Section 121, as amended, is hereby amended by
19 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

20 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM. From the capital improvement fund
21 there is hereby appropriated and authorized to be dispersed, the following amount for the






