1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the
2 hearing examiner to approve, subject to pre-effective and post-
3 effective conditions, reclassification of certain property, and
4 amending KCC Title 21A, as amended, by amending the zoning
5 map thereof, as designated in land use services file no.
6 L99TY401.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the
9 September 8, 2000, report and recommendation of the hearing examiner, which was filed with the
10 clerk of the council on September 15, 2000, on the application of Al Johnston for Raiz Qureshi, to
11 reclassify certain property described in land use services file no. L99TY401.

12 SECTION 2. The recommendation of the hearing examiner to reclassify the subject
13 property from CB-SO to CB-P is hereby adopted, subject to pre-effective and post-effective
14 conditions. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the land use services division shall amend

Ordinance 13955

15 the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.


