1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of
2 \$4,320,537 to employee benefits from employee benefits
3 fund balance to cover 1999 self-funded plan expenses paid in
4 2000 and self-insured benefit plan cost increases for 2000;
5 and amending the 2000 Budget Ordinance 13678, Section
6 110, as amended.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation
10 of \$4,320,537 to employee benefits from the employee benefits fund balance for the 1999
11 unanticipated year-end claims costs paid in 2000 and self insured benefit plan cost
12 increases for 2000.

13 SECTION 2. Ordinance 13678, Section 110, as amended, is hereby amended by
14 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

15 EMPLOYEE BENEFITS – From the employee benefits fund there is hereby
16 appropriated to:

17 Employee benefits \$4,320,537


18 PROVIDED THAT:

19 This appropriation shall be used only to cover costs of actual claims and
20 associated administrative expenses incurred in the existing benefit plans. The office of
21 human resources management shall monitor the actual claims expenses and propose to
22 the executive an additional expenditure plan if the actual claims experience in 2000
23 exceeds this appropriation authority.

Ordinance 13973 was introduced on 8/14/00 and passed as amended by the Metropolitan King County Council on 10/16/00, by the following vote:




