
11 SECTION 1. The memorandum of agreement negotiated between King County


16 SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of the memorandum of agreement, adopting and



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF PROFESSIONAL AND
TECHNICAL ENGINEERS, LOCAL 17-TRANSIT SUPERVISORS

AND KING COUNTY

FOR 11/1/2000-2/28/2001


This Memorandum of Agreement between IFPTE Local 17, and King County operates to extend for four calendar months the provisions of the current collective bargaining agreement between the parties, subject to ratification by the King County Council and the Union membership, with the following modifications:


Amends Article 23: Duration, as follows:

Section 1. Duration. This Agreement shall become effective November 1, 2000 and shall remain in effect through February 28, 2000.

All other provisions of the collective bargaining agreement expiring on October 31, 2000 remain in full force and effect.
