1 AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning; declaring it is the
2 intent of the King County council to support churches,
3 synagogues, and temples by facilitating the right to
4 worship; further declaring it is the intent of the King
5 County council to support public and private schools by
6 facilitating the educational process; repealing Ordinance
7 14045, Section 28, which enacts a moratorium on
8 acceptance of new permit applications in the RA zone for
9 all new public schools (except for remodels of existing
10 facilities and provisions of portable facilities) and public
11 school facilities, private schools and churches, synagogues
12 and temples and schools related to such religious facilities
13 and repealing Ordinance 14045, Section 29, which calls for
14 a task force to review issues involving nonresidential uses
15 in the Rural Area; and repealing Ordinance 14045, Section
16 28, and Ordinance 14045, Section 29.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. It is the intent of the King County council to support churches, synagogues, and temples by facilitating the right to worship. Also, it is the intent of the King County council to support public and private schools by facilitating the educational process. It is also the intent of the King County council to take steps needed to ensure environmental protection through adoption of land use and zoning regulations that are reasonable and constitutional. Therefore, the King County council finds that the moratorium should be lifted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 14045, Sections 28 and 29, are each hereby repealed.

Ordinance 14162 was introduced on 2/26/01 and passed as amended by the Metropolitan King County Council on 7/9/01, by the following vote:


