1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area  
2 known as First Intertie to King County Water District No.  
3 119 for the purpose of providing water service.

6 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

- 7 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as  
8 First Intertie for water service was filed with the county council on April  
9 3, 2002.
- 10 2. King County water district no. 119 has passed a resolution annexing  
11 certain property by the resolution method of RCW 57.24.170 in  
12 Resolution No. 398.
- 13 3. King County water district no. 119 issued a determination of  
14 nonsignificance on the proposed annexation dated November 7, 2001.
- 15 4. The utilities technical review committee recommended county council  
16 approval of the proposed annexation on April 10, 2002.

17           5. The county council held a public hearing on June 3, 2002, and has  
18           considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040(3).

19           BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

20           SECTION 1. Findings. The county council finds that:

21           A. The proposed action is in compliance with the county's Comprehensive Plan;

22           B. The proposed action is in compliance with the policies expressed in the  
23           district's plan for water or sewage facilities, or both.

24           SECTION 2. After consideration of the criteria listed in RCW 57.02.040(3), the  
25           annexation by King County water district no. 119 of the area known as the First Intertie  
26           Annexation and described in Attachment A to this ordinance is consistent with those  
27           criteria and is approved. Pursuant to RCW 57.02.045, this approval is final unless review  
28           is taken by the King County boundary review board under chapter 36.93 RCW.

29           SECTION 3. King County water district no. 119 is the appropriate entity to serve  
30           the area proposed to be annexed.

31           SECTION 4. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval



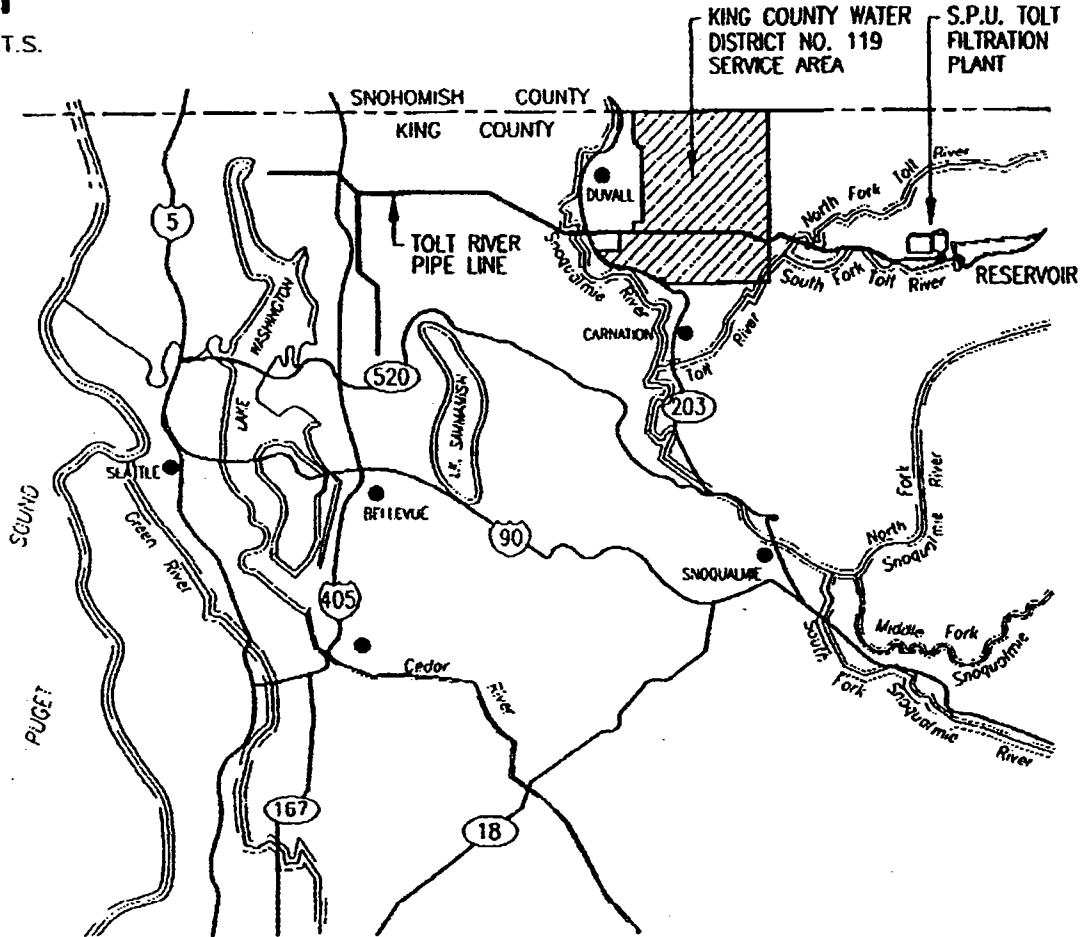


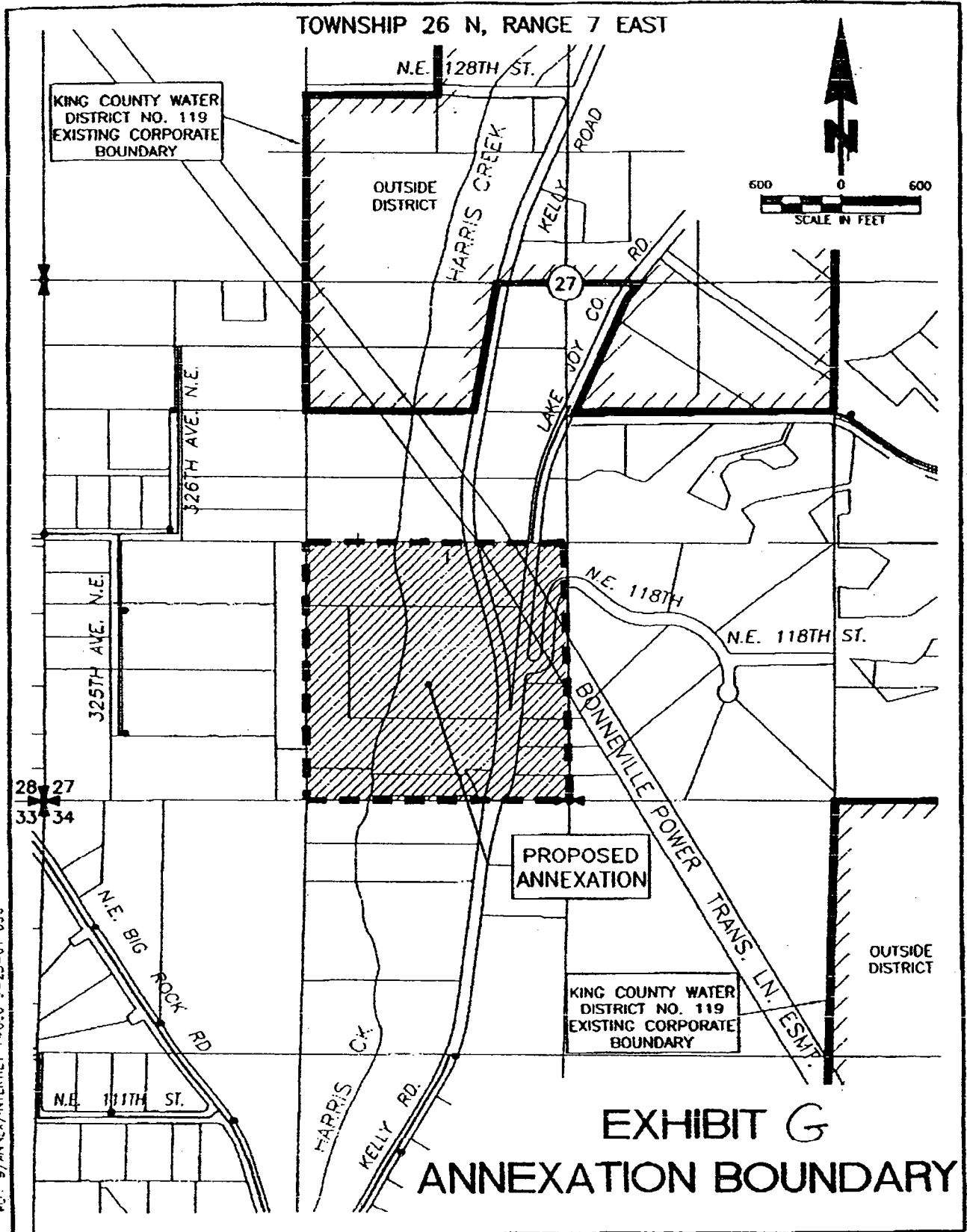
EXHIBIT F
