12 a part hereof.


13 SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from
14 ratification, through and including October 31, 2004.

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

Attachments A. Memorandum of Agreement By and Between King County and ATU, Local 587

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN
KING COUNTY
AND
ATU, LOCAL 587

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement ("Agreement") have recently ratified a collective bargaining agreement expiring in October of 2004 (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, subsequent to ratification of the Contract, the parties have discussed certain wages and working conditions that the parties failed to address in negotiations; and

WHEREAS, after discussion of these issues, the parties desire to revise the Contract as follows:

1. The changes to the Contract shall be effective the first full pay period following ratification of this Agreement by the Metropolitan King County Council.
2. The following classifications listed on Exhibit A of the Contract shall have their top step wages revised as follows:

a.	Senior Customer Assistance Representative	19.04	19.66
b.	Senior Rider Information Specialist	19.04	19.66
c.	Senior Accounting Representative	19.18	19.80
d.	Radio Equipment Specialist	24.78	25.45
e.	OSS Coordinator	32.32	33.48

3. Additionally, each incumbent in the above classifications shall receive a one time payment as follows: Senior Customer Assistance Representatives, Senior Rider Information Specialists and Senior Accounting Representatives (each \$650); Radio Equipment Specialists (\$500); OSS Coordinators (\$1,200).
4. 624-PASS employees shall be added to the pick for Customer Service Office Employees. Incumbent 624-PASS employees as of the effective date of this Agreement shall be grandfathered and exempted from this requirement.

5. Employees working light duty on industrial injury shall no longer be entitled to 4.5 hours per week of paid time off to visit the doctor. Employees on light duty must either use accrued leave or take approved leave without pay to visit the doctor.
