1 AN ORDINANCE extending the time for filing written
2 confirmations required in Ordinance 14446; and repealing
3 Ordinance 14446, Section 3, and Ordinance 14446, Section
4 4.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 **SECTION 1. Findings:** The council hereby finds the following facts:

9 A. TCI Cablevision of Washington, Inc., and Tele-Vue Systems, Inc.,
10 (“franchisees”) subsidiary corporations of Tele-Communications, Inc. (“TCI”), which is
11 now known as AT&T Broadband, LLC (“ATTB”), provide cable television service in
12 unincorporated King County pursuant to cable television franchises 12132 and 11680, as
13 amended (“franchise agreements”).

14 B. In compliance with the franchise agreements, franchisees, TCI and ATTB
15 requested approval of a proposed transfer of parental control of franchisees to a new
16 entity to be known as ATT Comcast Corporation (“ATT Comcast”).

17 C. On July 29, 2002, the council passed Ordinance 14446 approving the proposed
18 transfer of parental control conditioned on the written confirmation of ATT Comcast,
19 AT&T Broadband, LLC, ATTB, franchisees, TCI West, Inc., TCI Pacific, Inc., and the
20 applicable bonding company regarding certain provisions of Ordinance 14446.

21 D. The written confirmations required by Ordinance 14446 were to be filed with
22 the clerk of the council within thirty calendar days of the effective date of Ordinance
23 14446. Failure to file the written confirmations as required would result in a denial of the
24 proposed transfer as of the enactment date of Ordinance 14446.

25 E. The effective date of Ordinance 14446 was August 19, 2002. The written
26 confirmations required by Ordinance 14446 were filed with the clerk of the council on
27 October 24, 2002, and are attached to this ordinance. An amended written confirmation
28 letter was filed with the clerk of the council on November 18, 2002.

29 SECTION 2. Ordinance 14446, Section 3, and Ordinance 14446, Section 4, are
30 each hereby repealed.

31 SECTION 3. The written confirmations required by Ordinance 14446, as filed
32 with the clerk of the council on October 24, 2002, and November 18, 2002 are accepted.

33 SECTION 4. The franchisees' request for approval of the transfer of parental
34 control is granted as and the actions taken in this ordinance are retroactive to and shall be

35 as if all necessary actions were taken as of the effective date of Ordinance 14446, subject
36 to all conditions of Ordinance 14446 that have not been repealed by this ordinance.


