1 AN ORDINANCE determining the monetary requirements  
2 for the disposal of sewage for the fiscal year beginning  
3 January 1, 2004, and ending December 31, 2004, setting the  
4 sewer rate for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2004, and  
5 ending December 31, 2004, and approving the amount of the  
6 sewage treatment capacity charge for 2004; and amending  
7 Ordinance 12353, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C.  
8 4.90.010 and Ordinance 11398, Section 1, as amended, and  
9 K.C.C. 28.84.055.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

13 SECTION 1. Ordinance 12353, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 4.90.010 are  
14 each hereby amended to read as follows:

15 **Sewer rate.** Having determined the monetary requirements for the disposal of  
16 sewage, the council hereby adopts a ((2003)) 2004 sewer rate of twenty-three dollars and  
17 forty cents per residential customer equivalent per month. Once a sewer rate ordinance

18 becomes effective, the clerk of the council is directed to deliver a copy of the ordinance  
19 to each agency having an agreement for sewage disposal with King County.

20 **SECTION 2. Monetary requirements for the disposal of sewage for the fiscal**  
21 **year beginning January 1, 2004, and ending December 31, 2004.** The council hereby  
22 determines the monetary requirements for the disposal of sewage as follows:

23 Administration, operating, maintenance repair and replace (net of other income):

24 \$63,323,751

25 Establishment and maintenance of necessary working capital reserves: (\$1,390,826).

26 Requirements of revenue bond resolutions (not included in above items and net of  
27 interest income): \$129,405,318.

28 TOTAL: \$191,338,243.

29 **SECTION 3.** Ordinance 11398, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 28.84.055 are  
30 each hereby amended as follows:

31 **Metropolitan sewerage facility charge.** A. The amount of the 1994  
32 metropolitan sewage facility capacity charge adopted by K.C.C. 28.84.050.O shall be  
33 seven dollars per month per residential customer or residential customer equivalent for  
34 fifteen years.

35 B. The amount of the 1995 metropolitan sewage facility capacity charge adopted  
36 by K.C.C. 28.84.050.O shall be seven dollars per month per residential customer or  
37 residential customer equivalent for fifteen years.

38 C. The sewage treatment capacity charge shall be seven dollars per month per  
39 residential customer or equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring  
40 between and including January 1, 1996, and December 31, 1996.

41           D. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by K.C.C.  
42           28.84.050.O shall be seven dollars per month per residential customer or equivalent for  
43           fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and including January 1, 1997, and  
44           December 31, 1997.

45           E. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by K.C.C.  
46           28.84.050.O shall be ten dollars fifty cents per month per residential customer or  
47           equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and including  
48           January 1, 1998, and December 31, 1998.

49           F. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by  
50           K.C.C.28.84.050.O shall be ten dollars fifty cents per month per residential customer or  
51           equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and including  
52           January 1, 1999, and December 31, 1999.

53           G. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by  
54           K.C.C.28.84.050.O shall be ten dollars fifty cents per month per residential customer or  
55           equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and including  
56           January 1, 2000, and December 31, 2000.

57           H. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by  
58           K.C.C.28.84.050.O shall be ten dollars fifty cents per month per residential customer or  
59           equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and including  
60           January 1, 2001, and December 31, 2001.

61           I. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by  
62           K.C.C.28.84.050.O shall be seventeen dollars and twenty cents per month per residential

63 customer or equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and  
64 including January 1, 2002, and December 31, 2002.

65 J. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by  
66 K.C.C.28.84.050.O shall be seventeen dollars and sixty cents per month per residential  
67 customer or equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and  
68 including January 1, 2003, and December 31, 2003.

69 K. The amount of the sewage treatment capacity charge adopted by  
70 K.C.C.28.84.050.O shall be eighteen dollars per month per residential

71 customer or equivalent for fifteen years for sewer connections occurring between and  
72 including January 1, 2004, and December 31, 2004.
