1 AN ORDINANCE approving the Snoqualmie Pass Utility
2 District Wastewater Facilities Plan Update.

5 **PREAMBLE:**

6 K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for sewer
7 utilities as a prerequisite for granting right-of-way franchises and approval
8 of right-of-way construction permits.

9 The Snoqualmie Pass Utility District Wastewater Facilities Plan Update
10 (“plan”) discusses sewer service to existing and future populations within
11 the district's ten-square-mile service area. The service area includes
12 portions of both King County and Kittitas county, with approximately one
13 thousand five hundred acres of service area in King County.

14 Approximately two hundred homes and eighty-two thousand skiers are
15 currently served each year by the district.

16 The district currently treats sewage flows that average ninety-eight
17 thousand gallons per day. The treatment system consists of a two-cell

18 aerated lagoon with disinfection and spray disposal on a nearby forested
19 area. The treatment system and disposal area are both located in Kittitas
20 county.

21 The district projects that sewage flows in twenty years may reach over
22 three hundred fifty thousand gallons per day. To meet the projected
23 demand, the district is proposing to spend over ten million dollars to
24 expand and upgrade its sewage treatment system.

25 The King County utilities technical review committee reviewed and
26 approved the plan on January 8, 2003. The utilities technical review
27 committee recommends that the council approve the plan.

28 The district prepared a determination of nonsignificance for the plan on
29 December 13, 2002, in accordance with the state Environmental Policy
30 Act. The district adopted the plan on December 11, 2002. The state
31 department of ecology is currently reviewing the plan.


32 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

33 SECTION 1. The Snoqualmie Pass Utility District Wastewater Facilities Plan
34 Update, Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved without conditions.


