8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. A. K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and
10 distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter
11 29A.32 RCW for annual general elections held in King County.

12 B. RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is
13 included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall
14 formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the
15 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure.

16 C. Ordinance 14767 and Ordinance 14965 provide for submission to the voters at
17 the November 2, 2004, general election, proposed amendments to Article 2 of the King
18 County Charter.

19 D. Unless enacted as an emergency ordinance, there is insufficient time prior to
20 the deadline of September 17, 2004, to appoint the committees and thereby allow the
21 director of King County records, elections and licensing services to inform committee
22 members of their duties and deadlines for writing voters pamphlet statements.

23 SECTION 2. The manager of the records, elections and licensing services
24 division is hereby authorized and requested to prepare and distribute a local voters
25 pamphlet, pursuant to K.C.C. 1.10.010, for the special election called for in Ordinances
26 14767 and 14965, the cost of the pamphlet to be included as part of the cost of the special
27 election.

28 SECTION 3. Pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, the following individuals are
29 appointed to serve on the following voters pamphlet committees for King County Charter
30 Amendment 1:


