2	from various current expense agencies and making an
3 ·	appropriation of \$677,367 from various non-current
4	expense agencies for a total appropriation of \$3,569,063;
5	and amending the 2005 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance
6	15083, Sections 37, 38, 42, 45, 47, 61, 67, 73 and 106 and
7	repealing Ordinance 15124, Section 13.

10	PREAMBLE:
11	On February 14, 2005, the council adopted Proposed Ordinance 2005-
12	0039, Ordinance 15124, making corrections to Ordinance 15083, the 2005
13	Budget Ordinance. Through a programming and clerical error, Proposed
14	Ordinance 2005-0039, Sections 13 through 21, as amended by the budget
15	and fiscal management committee, were not included in Proposed
16	Substitute Ordinance 2005-0039 as it was considered by the council on
17	February 14. This ordinance repeals the incomplete Section 13 of

18	Ordinance 15124 and adopts Proposed Ordinance 2005-0039, Sections 13
19	through 21, as recommended by the budget and fiscal management
20	committee on February 9, 2005.
21	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
22	SECTION 1. From the current expense fund there is hereby approved and
23	adopted a total of \$2,891,696 to various current expense fund agencies.
24	From various non-current expense funds there is hereby approved and adopted
25	\$677,367 to various non-current expense agencies.
26	SECTION 2. Ordinance 15124, Section 13, is hereby repealed.
27	SECTION 3. Ordinance 15083, Section 37, as amended, is hereby amended by
28	adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

32	Of this appropriation, \$517,115 may not be expended or encumbered until the
33	council approves and adopts the collective bargaining agreement and one memorandum
34	of agreement negotiated by and between King County and Public, Professional and
35	Office-Clerical Employees and Drivers, Teamsters Local 763 under Proposed Ordinance
36	2004-0532.
37	P2 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:
88	Of this appropriation \$567,000 may not be expended or encumbered except after
39	compliance with the requirements of this proviso. The office of management and budget
10	shall submit quarterly reports on actual expenditures of the assessor's office to the

	council by April 29, July 29 and October 28, 2005, for the first, second and third quarter
	report, respectively. The reports shall be submitted on a reporting format developed by
	the office of management and budget in collaboration with staff of the council and the
	assessor's office. Each report initially shall be prepared by the assessor's office and then
	forwarded to the office of management and budget for review. The office of
·	management and budget shall submit each report, together with a proposed motion
	approving the report, to the council by the deadlines set forth above. Upon approval of
	each quarterly report by the council by motion, \$189,000 of the \$567,000 of the
	appropriation restricted by this proviso may be expended or encumbered. If any quarterly
	report submittal deadline is missed, appropriation authority for \$189,000 for each such
	deadline missed shall lapse and it shall revert to fund balance.
	The reports and motions required to be submitted by this proviso must be filed in
	electronic format and in the form of 15 paper copies with the clerk of the council, who
	will retain the original and will forward paper copies to each councilmember and to the
	lead staff for the budget and fiscal management committee or its successor.
