1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the change of name of King
2 County fire protection district no. 39 and King County fire
3 protection district no. 26, which were merged by the voters,
4 to "South King Fire and Rescue."

7 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

8 1. On September 20, 2005, the voters approved the merger of the Federal
9 Way fire department, King County fire protection district no. 39, and the
10 Des Moines fire department, King County fire protection district no. 26.

11 2. The boards of commissioners of both King County fire protection
12 district no. 39 and King County fire protection district no. 26 have
13 determined that it would be in the best interest of the district to change the
14 name of the merged fire districts to "South King Fire and Rescue."

15 3. Fire protection district no. 39 adopted Resolution No. 395 and fire
16 protection district no. 26 adopted Resolution No. 1164-05-05 on May 25,
17 2005, which was filed with the King County council on October 12, 2005,

18 resolving to change the name of the merged "South King Fire and
19 Rescue."

20 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

21 SECTION 1. The King County council, under RCW 52.30.060, approves the
22 change in the name of merged King County fire protection district no. 39 and King

County fire protection district no. 26 to "South King Fire and Rescue."







RESOLUTION NO. 396

RESOLUTION REQUESTING CHANGE OF NAME

(SPECIAL ELECTION)

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FEDERAL WAY FIRE DEPARTMENT, REQUESTING THAT THE NAME OF THE DISTRICT BE CHANGED TO SOUTH KING FIRE AND RESCUE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1ST 2006 PROVIDING THE MERGER OF KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 26 INTO FEDERAL WAY FIRE DEPARTMENT IS APPROVED BY VOTERS.

Background: WHEREAS, The Boards of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 and Federal Way Fire Department have approved the merger of the two Districts with Federal Way Fire Department being the merger district. King County Fire Protection District No. 26, the merging district, will cease to exist as a separate municipal corporation. The merger question has been placed on the primary election ballot for approval by the voters of District No. 26. The Boards of Commissioners of the two Districts believe that the name of the resulting District should be changed to South King Fire and Rescuc to be more descriptive of the area it will serve and the services it will provide. The request for the future name change is being made at this time because the information to be distributed to the public prior to the election and the merger ballot proposition should indicate the desired name of the district to properly inform the voters.

Resolution: NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Federal Way Fire Department, King County, Washington as follows:

Section 1. In order to inform the voters what the name of the District will be if the voters approve the merger, the Board of Commissioners requests that the King County Council approve the future name change of the Federal Way Fire Department to **South King Fire and Rescuc** at this time to be effective on the effective date of the merger if it is approved by the voters, January 1, 2006.

Section 2. RCW 52.30.060 requires approval by the county legislative authority to change the name of a fire district.



RESOLUTION NO. 395 for FEDERAL WAY FIRE DEPARTMENT (King County Fire Protection District #39)

RESOLUTION NO. 1164-05-05 for KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT #26

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS FOR THE FEDERAL WAY FIRE DEPARTMENT and THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 26 ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE PLAN FOR A MERGER.

WHEREAS, the Federal Way Fire Department and King County Fire Protection District No. 26 have heretofore entered into an agreement to work toward a merger of the two fire districts; and

WHEREAS, a "Merger Plan", which is attached to this resolution as Appendix A, has been successfully and satisfactorily developed, and supported in principle, by a majority of the Commissioners of each of the respective Districts; and

WHEREAS, a successor labor contract, which is attached to this resolution as Appendix B, has been successfully and satisfactorily negotiated; and

WHEREAS, a personnel manual covering all non-contract employees, which is attached as Appendix C, has been successfully and satisfactorily updated to include all Federal Way and District #26 non-contract employees; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of both Districts believe it would be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of each of the two Districts for a merger of the two Districts to be consummated; and

WHEREAS, RCW 52.06 provides a legal mechanism whereby two Fire Protection Districts in the State of Washington may merge under certain terms and conditions, and in accordance with statutory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 have petitioned for a merger with the Federal Way Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Federal Way Fire Department and the Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 agree that the proposed plan for the merger, as attached hereto, does demonstrate that a merger would be in the best interest of both Districts and their respective citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE FEDERAL WAY FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 26 THAT:

1. The "Plan" submitted for the merger of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 with the Federal Way Fire Department, for the reasons and on the terms and conditions stated therein, is hereby approved; provided, that the following Term or Condition is hereby added pursuant to RCW 52.06.:

- a) The merger shall be effective January 1st, 2006.
- b) The ballot title submitting the proposition of merger to the voters shall reflect that effective date ~~is~~.
- c) Prior to January 1, 2006, the Districts may enter into consolidated operations under an interlocal agreement.
- d) Prior to January 1, 2006, the Federal Way Fire Department Board of Commissioners shall adopt, by resolution, the name of **South King County Fire and Rescue**, serving the communities of Federal Way and Des Moines

2. In accordance with Chapter 52.06 of the Revised Code of Washington, the Board of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 shall adopt a resolution at the appropriate time calling for a special election in September of 2005 within the boundaries of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 for the purpose of presenting this question of the merger to the electors. The Commissioners of the Federal Way Fire Department hereby request that the Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 call for that special election by passing the appropriate resolution and notifying the King County Auditor and Elections Department.
