1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the county property tax
2 levies for collection in 2006, and implementing RCW
3 84.55.120.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. The council is under an obligation by charter to enact revenue
8 measures that support the budget appropriation ordinance by December 1, 2005, for the
9 2006 budget. This ordinance sets the amount of property tax to be collected for the
10 regular property tax levy, the road district levy, the conservation futures levy and the
11 emergency medical services levy. In accordance with RCW 84.55.120, the council has
12 given proper notice of this ordinance to the public.

13 SECTION 2. For collection of the property tax levies in 2006, the council hereby
14 authorizes property tax increases over the amounts authorized for collection in 2005 as
15 follows:

16 The increases shown above are exclusive of any amounts resulting from new construction
17 valued in 2005, any increases in value of state-assessed property for 2005 and any
18 amounts necessary to fund tax refunds paid in 2005. The increase in the regular levy
19 includes an estimated \$13,072,192 (exclusive of new construction) to be levied in
20 accordance with a voter-approved lid lift for veterans and human services.


21 SECTION 3. Upon enactment, the clerk is directed to forward this ordinance to
22 the assessor in accordance with RCW 84.52.070.


