9 SECTION 1. From various funds there is hereby approved and adopted a total of
10 \$781,847 to various agencies to fund contractual increases provided for in the labor
11 agreement between King County and Joint Crafts Council, Construction Crafts.

12 SECTION 2. Ordinance 15652, Section 27, as amended, is hereby amended by
13 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

14 FACILITIES MANAGEMENT - CX - From the current expense fund there is
15 hereby appropriated to:

16 Facilities management – CX \$26,890

39 EQUIPMENT RENTAL AND REVOLVING - From the equipment rental and
40 revolving fund there is hereby appropriated to:

41 Equipment rental and revolving \$254,518

42 SECTION 8. Ordinance 15652, Section 114, as amended, is hereby amended by
43 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

44 MOTOR POOL EQUIPMENT RENTAL AND REVOLVING - From the motor
45 pool equipment rental fund there is hereby appropriated to:

46 Motor pool equipment rental and revolving \$110,228
