1 AN ORDINANCE related to security for county facilities;
2 creating a security oversight panel and providing for an
3 implementation plan for security in downtown Seattle
4 facilities.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. A. The security oversight panel is hereby created.

8 B. The panel shall consist of the following members:

9 1. The executive or the executive's designee;

10 2. The manager of the facilities management division or the manager's designee;

11 3. The director of the office of management and budget or the manager's

12 designee;

13 4. The director of the Seattle-King County department of public health or the
14 director's designee;

15 5. The risk manager the risk manager's designee;

16 6. The chair of the council or the chair's designee;

17 7. The chair of the law, justice and human services committee, or its successor,
18 or the designee of the chair of the law, justice and human services committee, or its
19 successor committee;

20 8. The sheriff or the sheriff's designee;

21 9. The prosecuting attorney or the prosecuting attorney's designee;

22 10. The presiding judge of the superior court or the presiding judge's designee;

23 11. The presiding judge of the district court or the presiding judge's designee;

24 12. The assessor or the assessor's designee; and

25 13. The director of the department of adult and juvenile detention.

26 C. Staff to the panel shall be provided by the office of management and budget.

27 D.1. The panel shall develop a report on the following:

28 a. setting security policies for county-owned facilities;

29 b. identifying agency responsibility for all security, including coordination and
30 information;

31 c. identifying security performance measures;

32 d. establishing protocols for the sharing of security information, such as
33 incidents, threats and similar occurrences;

34 e. establishing protocols for reporting and dealing with threats against
35 employees;

36 f. the development of memoranda of understanding between the executive and
37 each separately elected agency for the provision of security;

38 g. reporting by responsible agencies on agreed-upon memoranda of
39 understanding and security performance indicators; and

40 h. future oversight recommendations.

41 2. By June 1, 2008, the panel shall file eleven copies of the report with the clerk
42 of the council, who shall distribute copies to each councilmember.

43 SECTION 2. A. The executive shall develop an implementation plan for security
44 in buildings that house county employees in the area bounded by Interstate 5, South King
45 Street, the Alaska Way South and Madison Street.

46 B. By June 1, 2008, the executive shall file the plan and any proposed legislation
47 required to implement the plan in the form of twelve copies with the clerk of the council,


48 who shall forward copies to each councilmember and to the lead staff for the law, justice
49 and human services committee, or its successor.


