1 AN ORDINANCE making a net supplemental
2 appropriation of \$26,952,134 to two non-current expense
3 funds, including a supplemental appropriation of
4 \$2,815,286 to the marine division and \$24,136,848 to the
5 King County flood control contract fund and deleting a
6 current expense fund proviso for cable communications;
7 and amending the 2008 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance
8 15975, Sections 27, 92, 112 and 130, as amended, and
9 Attachment B, as amended.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

12 SECTION 1. From the flood control contract fund there is hereby approved and
13 adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$24,136,848 to King County flood control
14 contract fund to implement capital contracts, and from the marine division operating fund
15 there is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$2,815,286 to the
16 marine division to implement operational and capital programs, and deleting a proviso for
17 cable communications in the current expense fund. The King County flood control

18 capital contract fund is disappropriated from the general government capital improvement
19 section.

20 SECTION 2. Ordinance 15975, Section 27, is hereby amended by adding thereto
21 and inserting therein the following:

22 CABLE COMMUNICATIONS - From the current expense fund there is hereby
23 appropriated to:

34 SECTION 4. Ordinance 15975, Section 112, as amended, is hereby amended by

36 MARINE DIVISION – From the marine operating fund there is hereby

39 SECTION 5. Ordinance 15975, Section 130, as amended, is hereby amended by
40 deleting the following:

41 From the king county flood control capital contract fund there is hereby
42 disappropriated the following amount identified in Attachment A to this ordinance.






