1 AN ORDINANCE relating to county automotive parking
 2 facilities; and amending Ordinance 8753, Section 6, as
 3 amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.045 and Ordinance 12077,
 4 Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.055.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 8753, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.045 are
 8 each hereby amended to read as follows:

9 Based on availability of parking, the short-term rates for county employee parking
 10 at the Goat Hill parking garage shall be as follows:

11 A. Daily parking: (~~ten~~ ~~thirteen~~) fifteen dollars.

12 B. Hourly parking: Hourly public parking rates shall apply up to a maximum of
 13 (~~thirteen~~) fifteen dollars per day for automobiles and four dollars per day for
 14 motorcycles; and

15 C. The rate for after-hours parking beginning after 1:30 p.m. on weekdays and on
 16 weekends and holidays shall be (~~five~~) seven dollars per day.

17 SECTION 2. Ordinance 12077, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.055 are
18 each hereby amended to read as follows:

19 A. Monthly employee and county vehicle rates for parking in the Goat Hill
20 parking garage, the Chinook Building, the King County Correctional Facility, open
21 surface parking lots that are designated by rule to be subject to parking charges shall be
22 as follows:

31 B. The facilities management division of the department of executive services
32 shall identify surface parking lots where it is reasonable and feasible to charge employees
33 for monthly parking. These surface parking lots are located at county facilities outside
34 the downtown Seattle metropolitan core and include, but are not limited to, district courts,
35 health centers, alcohol treatment facilities, police precincts, youth service centers and
36 similar facilities. Designation of open surface lots that are subject to parking charges
37 shall occur by administrative rule adopted pursuant to K.C.C. 3.32.010.

38 C. For county employees with disabilities that make it difficult or impossible to
39 use public transit, and who display a disabled parking permit, the fee for covered parking



40 shall be fifty percent of the normal rate rounding up to the next even dollar and applies to
41 all King County facilities management division managed parking facilities. Employees
42 with disabilities shall receive first priority in the assignment of available parking stalls.

County Council on 2/23/2009, by the following vote:




