1 AN ORDINANCE related to county payment of volunteer  
2 parking; and amending Ordinance 15648, Section 2, as  
3 amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.006.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. Ordinance 15648, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.006 are  
6 each hereby amended to read as follows:

7 The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context  
8 clearly requires otherwise.

9 A. "After hours parking" means work time parking for employees whose normal  
10 work shifts begin after 1:30 p.m. and end between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. or who are  
11 required to come into work after 4:30 p.m. "After hours parking" also includes parking  
12 on weekends and holidays that is required by the employee's agency.

13 B. "Business convenience" means a county business-related requirement. For the  
14 purposes of this chapter, "a county business-related requirement" includes after hours  
15 parking for county employees, parking for commissioned sheriff's office personnel,  
16 ~~((parking for county volunteers specifically authorized by ordinance to park in county  
17 automotive parking facilities at no charge,))~~ parking for county employees working for a  
18 specified and limited period on a time-sensitive project that requires them to arrive before  
19 or stay after regular work hours ~~((and)),~~ parking for county employees who are required

20 as part of their jobs to use their private vehicles to routinely travel to multiple county  
21 business locations (~~and~~), parking for county-owned vehicles and paid parking for  
22 county volunteers authorized by ordinance or by any presiding elected official as defined  
23 by K.C.C. 3.24.010 or the presiding elected official's designee, but for the executive  
24 branch any designee must be at least the highest-ranking employee of a division.

25 C. "County automotive parking facility" means:

- 26 1. The Goat Hill parking garage located at Sixth Avenue and Jefferson in  
27 Seattle;
- 28 2. The parking structure located at the regional justice center in Kent;
- 29 3. County adult detention center parking facilities located at Fifth Avenue and  
30 James in Seattle;
- 31 4. Open surface lots that are owned or leased by the county; and
- 32 5. The Chinook Building parking located at Fifth-Avenue and Jefferson in  
33 Seattle.

34 D. "County volunteer" means a person who is not a county employee, who  
35 performs service for the county for civic, charitable or humanitarian reasons, without  
36 promise, expectation or receipt of compensation from the county for services rendered  
37 and who is accepted as a volunteer by the county. "County volunteer" includes, but is not  
38 limited to, a person serving as a board member, officer, commission member, volunteer  
39 intern or direct service volunteer.

40 E. "Director" means the director of the county department of executive services  
41 and his or her successor or designee, unless otherwise specified in this chapter.


42 F. "Public parking" means general purpose parking by persons who are not  
43 county employees and by county employees that park for less than a full day.

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Ordinance 17035 was introduced on 2/14/2011 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 2/22/2011, by the following vote:




