1	AN ORDINANCE	approving the City of Seattle 2013
2	Water System Plan	
3	STATEMENT OF FACTS	S:
4	1. King County has adopt	ed K.C.C. chapter 13.24, which requires
5	approval of comprehensiv	e plans for water utilities that distribute or obtain
6	water in unincorporated K	ing County as a prerequisite for operating in
7	unincorporated King Cour	ity, receiving approval for annexation proposals,
8	being granted right-of-way	franchises, and being given approval for right-
9	of-way construction permi	ts. K.C.C. 13.24.060 prescribes the
10	requirements for approval	of such plans, including consistency with state
11	and local planning require	ments.
12	2. RCW 70.116.050 requi	res that general comprehensive plans for water
13	within critical water suppl	y service areas be submitted to, and approved
14	by, the legislative authorit	y within whose boundaries all or a portion of a
15	utility lies.	
16	3. The city of Seattle's last	water system plan was prepared in 2007. Both
17	Washington state Departm	ent of Health ("DOH") and King County

regulations require water system plans to be updated every six years.

19	4. The city's service area is within a critical water supply service area and
20	has adopted a Water System Plan ("the plan").
21	5. King County has adopted a Comprehensive Plan that includes water
22	supply policies in its provisions for facilities and services (policies F-107
23	through F-253) that call for consistency with other adopted plans, support
24	for regional water supply planning, pursuit of reclaimed water, water
25	conservation and protection of water resources.
26	6. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
27	("the UTRC") to review and make a recommendation to the King County
28	executive and council on the plan and the requirements under K.C.C.
29	chapter 13.24 and consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan
30	The UTRC has reviewed the planning data and city operations and has
31	found:
32	a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
33	Puget Sound Regional Council for the city's service area;
34	b. Portions of the city's service area are in unincorporated King County;
35	c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
36	service needs;
37	d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
38	laws, including the evaluation of reclaimed water use;
39	e. the city did not request and the UTRC did not evaluate the plan's
40	proposed change in service area and subsequent change to water right or

41	rights place of use. Consequently, this ordinance does not change the
42	city's water right or rights place of use under RCW 90.03.386; and
43	f. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
44	policies.
45	7. The DOH approval of the city's plan is pending King County council
46	action.
47	8. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the city issued a
48	determination of nonsignificance for the issuance of the plan on April 2,
49	2012, and there were no appeals.
50	9. The city's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
51	administrative and planning standards. As the city's operations, facilities
52	and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code, and are
53	consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the UTRC has
54	recommended approval of the plan.
55	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Seattle 2013 Water System Plan, Attachment A to this

ordinance, is hereby approved as a water system plan.
