1           AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive  
2           to enter into amendments to interlocal cooperation  
3           agreements with the cities of Auburn and Bothell to  
4           disburse conservation futures tax levy funds appropriated  
5           under Ordinance 17855.

6           STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 7           1. King County conservation futures tax levy funds are collected  
8           throughout King County as a dedicated portion of the property tax for the  
9           acquisition of open space and resource lands.
- 10          2. Ordinance 14714 established procedures for the annual allocation of  
11          conservation futures tax levy funds, which directs the conservation futures  
12          citizens committee to make funding recommendations to the King County  
13          executive to consider for inclusion in the annual budget ordinance.
- 14          3. The executive has received and considered the conservation futures  
15          citizens committee funding recommendations and has included them in  
16          Ordinance 17855, in which the King County council has appropriated  
17          conservation futures funds to the city open space projects listed and  
18          described in Attachment B to this ordinance.

19           4. King County must sign conservation futures interlocal cooperation  
20           agreements or amend existing conservation futures interlocal agreements  
21           to disburse funds to the particular jurisdictions.

22           5. King County and the cities are authorized to enter into an interlocal  
23           agreement under chapter 39.34 RCW, the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

24           BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

25           SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into, and  
26           execute amendments to, interlocal cooperation agreements containing language,  
27           substantially similar to that in Attachment A to this ordinance, necessary for the

28 disbursement of conservation futures tax levy funds appropriated under Ordinance 17855,  
29 for the city open space projects listed and described in Attachment B to this ordinance.

**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION FUTURES  
INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND THE CITY OF \_\_\_\_\_  
FOR OPEN SPACE ACQUISITION PROJECTS**

**Preamble**

The King County Council, through Ordinance 9128, has established a Conservation Futures Levy Fund and appropriated proceeds to King County, the City of Seattle and certain suburban cities. This amendment is entered into to provide for the allocation of additional funds made available for open space acquisition.

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the CITY OF \_\_\_\_\_ and KING COUNTY, and amends and attaches to and is part thereof of the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement entered into between the parties on the \_\_\_\_ day of (Month), (Year), as previously amended.

The parties agree to the following amendments:

**Amendment 1: Article 1. Recitals**

A paragraph is hereby added to the Recitals Section to provide for a Conservation Futures Levy Fund allocation for the \_\_\_\_\_ Acquisition, and hereafter reads:

Subject to the terms of this agreement, the County will provide Conservation Futures Levy Funds in the amounts shown in Attachments A through \_\_, to be

The City may request additional funds; however, the County has no obligation to provide funds to the City for the Projects in excess of the total amounts shown in Attachments A through \_\_. The County assumes no obligation for the future support of the Projects described herein except as expressly set forth in this agreement.

**AMENDMENT 4: Attachment \_\_**

The Attachments to the interlocal agreement are hereby amended by adding Attachment \_\_, which is hereby attached to the interlocal agreement, incorporated therein and made a part thereof.

In all other respects, the terms, conditions, duties and obligations of both parties shall remain the same as agreed to in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as previously amended.

This document shall be attached to the existing Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.

## Conservation Futures (CFT) Project Descriptions

### Suburban City CFT Projects:

#### 1122033 Auburn – Les Gove Park Expansion

This is a four-parcel acquisition project totaling 1.44 acres on Auburn Way at 12th Street SE in downtown Auburn. The primary purpose of the project is to create a visual presence for Les Gove Park from Auburn Way South, one of Auburn's most traveled thoroughfares.

2014: \$100,000 is transferred to this project from the abandoned City of Auburn Chuck Perry Property, as this project has an acquisition funding shortfall.

#### 1047239 BTH-Fries Family LLC – North Creek Woods

This is a multiple-parcel project located in Bothell west of I-405, immediately south of the Snohomish County line. The property contains woodlands with urban wildlife and serves as a highly visible regional separator at the boundary of King and Snohomish Counties that is highly visible from I-405.

2014: This project will receive \$305,000 from the abandoned City of Bothell Williams Property acquisition CFT project.
