1 AN ORDINANCE setting the annual use payment for
2 continuing use of the county road rights-of-way as
3 authorized in right-of-way use agreements for wireless
4 telecommunications facilities; and amending Ordinance
5 17515, Section 13, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.675.060,
6 Ordinance 13734, Section 4, as amended, and K.C.C.
7 14.45.020.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes to the annual use
10 payment currently charged for right-of-way use agreements by clarifying wireless
11 communication facility antenna support structures, establishing a new annual use
12 payment amount and revising the adjusted rate.

13 B. These fees are assessed pursuant to K.C.C.299.030.

14 SECTION 2. Ordinance 17515, Section 13, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.675.060
15 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

16 A. The annual use payment for continuing use of the county rights-of-way ((as
17 follows)) for wireless communications facilities shall be the following amounts for 2017
18 and, for each year thereafter, the 2017 amount adjusted as provided in subsection C. of
19 this section:

32	<u>Single element wireless installation. Single</u>	\$2,000
33	<u>((A)) antenna ((/receiver transmitter (on an existing or</u>	
34	<u>replacement pole) and)) <u>or</u> equipment cabinet</u>	
35	<u>((, but not both)) <u>on a new, existing or replacement</u></u>	
36	<u>antenna support structure.</u>	

37 B. For the purpose of this section, "replacement pole" means a new utility pole
 38 replacing an existing utility pole in the county right-of-way with no increase in the total
 39 number of utility poles in the right-of-way. Replacement poles provide extra capacity to
 40 support attached wireless telecommunications facilities.

41 C. ~~((A))~~ The amount of the annual use payments ~~((prescribed))~~ established by
 42 subsection A. of this section shall be automatically ~~((escalated))~~ adjusted annually,

43 beginning January 1, ~~((2004))~~ 2018, and every year thereafter, ~~((for the change in))~~
44 using the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer January
45 through December Price Index for All Urban Consumers ("CPI-U") for the Seattle-
46 Tacoma-Bremerton Statistical Metropolitan Area for the year preceding the prior
47 calendar year of the agreement's implementation. However, if the CPI-U is negative,
48 there will be no adjustment. In the event the CPI-U ~~((or a successor or substitute~~
49 ~~index)))~~ is no longer published, a reliable government or other ~~((non-partisan))~~
50 nonpartisan index of inflation selected by the county shall be used to calculate the
51 adjusted amounts.

52 SECTION 3. Ordinance 13734, Section 4, and K.C.C. 14.45.020 are each hereby
53 amended to read as follows:

54 The ~~((following terms shall be applicable to this chapter:))~~ definitions in this
55 section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

56 A. "Antenna support structure" means any pole, post, tower or other structure
57 supporting, permitted and sufficient for the mounting and operation of wireless
58 communications facilities.

59 B. "Array" means more than one antenna on the same support structure.

60 C. "Right-of-way" ((is)) means land, property or property interest, such as an
61 easement, usually in a strip, as well as bridges, trestles~~((;))~~ or other structures, dedicated
62 to, or otherwise acquired by the county, for public motor vehicle transportation purposes,
63 including, but not limited to, roads, streets, avenues~~((;))~~ and alleys, whether or not
64 opened, improved or maintained for public motor vehicle transportation purposes.

65 ~~((B.))~~ D. "Right-of-way use agreement" ~~((is))~~ means an agreement between the
66 county and a wireless telecommunications provider through which is granted a site-
67 specific and revocable privilege to use county right-of-way at a location identified in the
68 agreement for wireless telecommunications facilities, and through which are set forth the
69 terms and conditions for exercising the granted privilege to use the county right-of-way.

70 ~~((C.))~~ E. "Wireless" means transmissions through the airwaves including, but not
71 limited to, infrared line of sight, cellular, microwave or satellite.

72 F. "Wireless telecommunications facility" ~~((is))~~ means the capital, equipment and
73 property, including, but not limited to, the poles and other antenna support structures,
74 pipes, mains, conduits, ducts, pedestals~~((;))~~ and electronic equipment within the right-of-
75 way used for the purpose of transmitting, receiving, distributing, providing~~((;))~~ or
76 offering wireless telecommunications.

77 ~~((D.))~~ G. "Wireless telecommunications provider" ~~((is))~~ means every person that
78 owns, controls, operates or manages a wireless minor telecommunication facility within
79 the county right-of-way for the purpose of offering wireless telecommunication services
80 ~~((i.e.))~~. For the purposes of this subsection, "wireless telecommunication services"
81 means transmission for hire of information in electronic or optical form, including, but
82 not limited to, voice, video~~((;))~~ or data~~((;))~~.

83 ~~((E. "Wireless" means transmissions through the airwaves including, but not~~

84 ~~limited to, infrared line of sight, cellular, microwave, or satellite.))~~

85 SECTION 4. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2017.


Ordinance 18410 was introduced on 10/3/2016 and passed as amended by the Metropolitan King County Council on 11/14/2016, by the following vote:


