1 AN ORDINANCE approving the Lake Forest Park Water  
2 District Comprehensive Water System Plan, August 31,  
3 2016.

4 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 5 1. RCW 57.16.010 requires that general comprehensive plans by special  
6 purpose districts be submitted to, and approved by, the legislative  
7 authority within whose boundaries all or a portion of a utility lies. K.C.C.  
8 chapter 13.24 prescribes the requirements for approval of those plans,  
9 including consistency with state and local planning requirements.
- 10 2. Lake Forest Park Water District has a service area within King County  
11 and has adopted a water system plan update ("the plan").
- 12 3. The district's last general water facility plan was approved in 2006.  
13 Washington state Department of Health and King County regulations  
14 require water system plans to be updated every six years.
- 15 4. King County has adopted a Comprehensive Plan that includes policies  
16 F-101 through F-254, the applicable portions of which address water  
17 policies for facilities and services; these water policies call for consistency  
18 with other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water conservation  
19 and protection of water resources.

20 5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee  
21 to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and  
22 council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and  
23 consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities  
24 technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and system  
25 operations and has found:

26 a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the  
27 Puget Sound Regional Council;

28 b. The district's service area is within King County;

29 c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and  
30 service needs;

31 d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality  
32 laws; and

33 e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and  
34 policies.

35 6. Washington state Department of Health approval is pending upon King  
36 County's approval of the plan.

37 7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the district completed an  
38 environmental check list and issued a determination of nonsignificance for  
39 the plan approval on September 8, 2016. There were no appeals.

40 8. The district's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,  
41 administrative and planning standards. As the district's operations,  
42 facilities and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code

43 and are consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities  
44 technical review committee has recommended approval of the plan.

45 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


46 SECTION 1. The Lake Forest Park Water District Comprehensive Water System


