1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive
2 to execute an amendment to the interlocal agreement with
3 the King County flood control zone district extending the
4 duration of the interlocal agreement through December 31,
5 2019; and declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Findings:

8 A. King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District have entered
9 into the Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the King County Flood Control
10 Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services, effective January 1, 2016.

11 B. The county and the district desire to amend the interlocal agreement to extend
12 its term from December 31, 2018 to December 31, 2019.

13 C. The first amendment to the interlocal agreement, Attachment A to this
14 ordinance, amends the interlocal agreement to extend its term through December 31,
15 2019.

16 D. Immediate approval of the amendment to the interlocal agreement is necessary
17 so that the county can continue to provide flood protection services and to implement the
18 district's work plan for the year 2019.

19 SECTION 2. The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an

20 amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the King County
21 Flood Control Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services, substantially in the
22 form of Attachment A to this ordinance. All other provisions of the interlocal agreement
23 shall remain in full force and effect.

24 SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency
25 exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,

26 health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public

27 institutions.



**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
KING COUNTY AND THE KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT
REGARDING FLOOD PROTECTION SERVICES**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the “Interlocal Agreement between King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services” (“Agreement”), is entered into by KING COUNTY, a home rule charter County in the State of Washington (“County”) and KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT, a quasi-municipal corporation of the State of Washington (“District”), and shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.

The Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The text of Section 13.1 is deleted and replaced with the following:

This Agreement shall take effect January 1, 2016 and shall remain in effect through December 31, 2019.

All other terms of the Agreement not amended by this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
